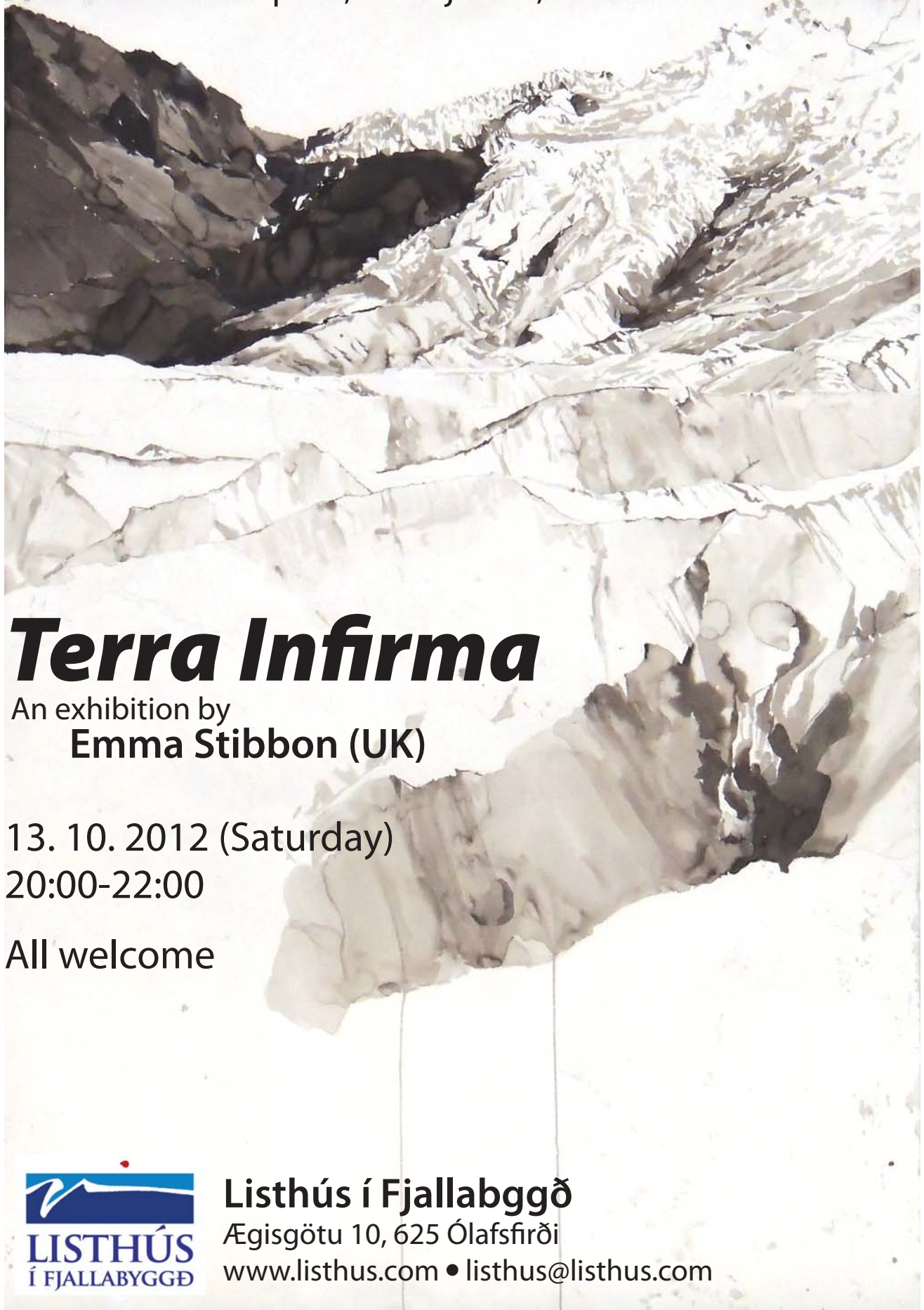

Terra Infirma is a solo show by British artist Emma Stibbon, created while on residency at the Listhus Artspace in Ólafsfjörður, Iceland during Sept & Oct 2012.

Stibbon's practice addresses environments that are in a condition of flux or change. In *Terra Infirma* she focuses on the unstable terrain of Iceland, a landscape characterized by volcanoes, geothermal springs and glaciers. In this exhibition her large-scale drawings and an animation reflect on these shifts of nature.

Emma Stibbon studied Fine Art BA Hons at Goldsmiths, London and Research Fine Art MA at the University of the West of England, Bristol, she is Senior Lecturer Fine Art Printmaking at the University of Brighton.

Recent solo exhibitions include the Stadtmuseum, Berlin, upstairs berlin, R O O M, London, and the Scott Polar Research Institute, Cambridge. Other projects include the Stiftung Federkiel residency at the Spinnerei, Leipzig, the 4th International Gyumri Biennale, Armenia. and a recent Derek Hill scholarship residency at the British School at Rome. Her work is held in private and public collections including the Stadtmuseum, Berlin and the Victoria and Albert Museum, London.
