

## **SKAMMDEGI FESTIVAL '17**

Artists' residencies exist all over the world. They provide an opportunity and a creative space in which artists can produce their work. The artist residency, Skammdegi, offering two months in the Dark Winter, is not something that many artists are drawn to. And yet, artists come from all over the world to experience this unique challenge in the small community of Olafsfjordorur, North Iceland. Eighteen artists of all backgrounds and persuasions came for the December and January 2016-17 residency. They came from eight countries. They came wanting the opportunity of an immersive and distant environment outside of their own familiar world. The experience removes them from the expectations and chatter of a competitive art world into the unknown world of prolonged darkness that very few places on earth can offer.

They want to know, "what kind of world exists in this remote place on the planet?" And, "what will this open for me in my consciousness?" and, "how will my experiences and perceptions here translate into my own work?"

You'll see here in the Festival the work of the artists who have worked hard to reflect their experiences and personal impressions of the landscape, the culture, the weather, the people. You will witness the variety of ideas, sources, materials, and inspirations that have resulted in the work they put forward. Enjoy!

Over the course of the four-day Festival five artists will exhibit and perform work that meet the challenges of this interesting venue opportunity at **LANDSBJÖRG**. They have chosen this site for its unusual possibilities and to see what happens with the juxtaposition of contemporary art in a building that does not conform to typical standards of art exhibition.

Composer **Jeffery Shivers** will present three compositions **slaggrinding** in a **throughfeed system**, **bulk modulus and eismatrix[0]**, which engage different issues of sound and space through variations of technology, illumination and interactivity.

**Leung Ka-lun** will exhibit his video work **zero-sum** which reflects on the relation between nature and culture, placing an investigation into the inner states and connections to the animal consciousness we all possess.

Landsbjörg & Kaffi Klara are both the sites for **Kim Munro**'s immersive audio documentary **Why do the ducks not fly south?**, which maps natural histories and small local rituals gathered throughout her wanderings in local communities. The piece has an accompanying online interactive element.

**Caitlín Thomson** has engaged the community in making colourful lanterns. The work *Lighting up Ólafsfjörður with colour* will light up the dark days of winter.

You will experience an intimate breakfast in *The BREAK / FAST* hosted by **Suzann Cheng** that will be recreated from her use of disposable cameras circulated throughout the Ólafsfjörður community.

**LISTHUS GALLERY** is an exhibition space that allows for a variety of mediums to be shown. Here you will view sculpture, photographs, paintings, ceramic works, and drawings. This venue will display the work of seven artists who interpret the community, the land, and the people using a variety of familiar and unusual materials.

**Corinne Weidmann** creates paintings of abstracted landscapes by accessing the dynamic forces and elements that shaped the earth surrounding Olafsfjordur in her work *Under the Surface*.

**Katherine Kavanaugh**'s *Earth Out of Balance* transforms the endless supply of kelp into a sculptural narrative about the political and environmental shifts and ruptures of our time. She will also exhibit a series of two and three-dimensional drawings.

**Hólmfríður Vídalín Arngrímsdóttir**'s ceramic pieces *Pað sem sést og ekki sést / That Which is Seen and Not Seen* deal with "how the past holds many generations of people who have left us to go on the long journey, but are still among us in spirit -- in the light and in the shadows."

Through the use of the available materials of cotton, acrylic medium, and basalt sand **Tammy McClennan** creates three-dimensional work *I Will Carry the Creatures With Me*.

**Robert Atwater** presents a dozen small, jewel like photographs of Ólafsfjördur and Siglufjördur in his work **South of True North**, which show the everyday streets and backyards of the villages.

**Caitlín Thomson**'s *lost treasure/found* treasure explores and reinterprets the symbolic and aesthetic value of both natural and manmade found objects.

**Hronn Helgadottir** & **Alkistis Terzi** present work that carries the theme of **Portraits**.

**TJARNARBORG** allows for the presentation of multiple performance work including dance, theater, new compositions, collaborations of sound, dance, and music.

**Priscila Chu**'s music theater piece **BATTLE** uses irony to express the dilemmas and challenges that surround each one of us in the current era.

**Katrine Faber** will perform a theater piece *Tales From The Trash* - A Work In Progress with stories, texts, songs, sounds and physical images grounded in Olafsfjordur, modern civilization and the old Norse Edda poem Völuspá.

An interactive dance theater piece *Memomentry* by dancer **Chan Wan Lok Michelle** is described by her: "Each moment is a miracle encompassing everything: the joy and sorrow, the failure and success, the disappointment and happiness, the celebration and grief."

Thora Karlsdottir will show video titled Sauðsvart / In the countryside.

**Gabrielle Cerberville** presents *between the flo/es*, a conceptual sound sculpture centered around the tenuous relationship with the natural world in her work, specifically the human role in climate change.

**Lara Stefansdottir** & **Hronn Helgadottir** & **Alkistis Terzi** present a collaborative visual representation with dancer **Ioanna Kerasopoulou** from the novel **The Child of Nature**.

**Alkistis Terz** presents a *dance video* of an improvisational dance piece performed by dancer **Ioanna Kerasopoulou** which reveals the transition from city life to the natural world, translating the elements of nature: mountains-fire-water.

Apart from the main venues, more artworks are presented at several satellite locations in Ólafsfjörður.


